Completion of an accredited master's, post-master's, or doctorate from an NP program AND

Current certification by the National Certification Corporation for the Obstetric, Gynecologic, and Neonatal Nursing Specialties (NCC) OR acute/critical care neonatal certification by the American Association of Critical Care Nurses (AACN)

AND

Current active certification by the Board of Nursing or the state of New Mexico as an advanced nurse practitioner or Certified Neonatal Nurse Practitioner AND

Maintain current BLS and current area specific advance life support certification (i.e. NRP) as

required by job if applicable

**Required current experience:** Demonstrated current competency and provision of care, reflective of the scope of privileges requested, for an adequate number of patients during the past 12 months, or successful completion of master's / post-masters degree within the past 12 months.
